



### **Volunteers Needed – June 2023:**

As a Volunteer led Club, we always need and welcome new Volunteers. We have some specific roles below that we need to fill. #### **(1) Learn to Swim (LTS) Coordinator**

Our Learn to Swim program is in need of a LTS Coordinator. This is predominantly an administrative role working alongside our teaching team to help manage enquiries, trials and movement of swimmers between groups, helping coordinate volunteer poolside assistants.

##### **Skills**

- Enthusiastic and organised with basic computer skills
- Willing to learn about the LTS program

##### **Commitment**

- ~2 hours per week, including some time at the pool (Tuesday / Thursday 6.15pm) especially whilst onboarding and over-seeing trials
- Attendance at bi-monthly committee meetings

#### **(2) Learn to Swim (LTS) Poolside Assistants / Teachers:**

Our Learn to Swim program is in need of some additional poolside assistants and teachers. This is a poolside role working as part of the teaching team on a Tuesday and / or Thursday evening (6.15pm – 7.15pm).

##### **Skills**

- Enthusiastic and a clear communicator
- Willing to learn how to assist in teaching swimming. (You will get lots of support from our qualified teachers)
- The Club will also fund any Swim England training to become a qualified Assistant Teacher / Teacher if you want to progress further.

##### **Commitment**

- ~1.5 hours per week
- DBS and Safeguarding training will be required (arranged by the Club)



### **(3) Swimming Officials – J1:**

As a Club we are responsible for providing Officials to all Open Meets that we attend... and many of our current Officials' swimmers are now leaving for University / are no longer swimming with us. J1 Officials are responsible for time keeping and judging turns at competitions. This is a great way to volunteer if your swimmer is starting to attend Open Meets as it keeps you busy during those long days waiting for races!

#### **Skills**

- No swimming experience necessary – all training and mentoring will be given.
- Able to observe swimmers, make decisions (with the help of the referee if needed) and operate a stop watch!
- Interest in ensuring Meets are conducted in a fair and safe manner

#### **Commitment**

- Completion of Swim England J1 Technical Official training
- Self sign up to Meets which your swimmer is attending
